Powerful sound



In order to support performing in a wide range of different situations, the keyboard's 2.5-watt stereo amplifier delivers quite a punch. Combined with high-quality Yamaha voices, this allows you to enjoy the realistic sound of acoustic and electric instruments in addition to ethnic instruments from many different nations and regions.

Metronome and Duo mode



In addition to a metronome for use when practicing, the PSR-F50 also offers a Duo mode, which allows two people to play together on the same instrument. This can be very useful when performing live and also during lessons.

Headphones output jack



You can use this jack not only to practice without disturbing others but also to connect the instrument to the sound system when playing on-stage. (Headphones :No Bundled)

Also runs on batteries



In situations where AC mains power is not available, the PSR-F50 can be operated using batteries instead. It requires six 1.5-V AA size batteries, which can be either rechargeable (1.2V Ni-MH rechargeable batteries or equivalent) or non-rechargeable.

Music stand



The keyboard comes complete with a music stand for holding sheet music.
